Several Units have adopted the schedule and chose either a Single, Double or Triple work period adjustment.

Created a rough draft of the schedule

Drafts were given to firefighter's to help with feedback.

On behalf of an estimated 90 firefighter's, it was presented to the Riverside County L2881 Chapter.

(Division & Deputy Chiefs)

MVU - City of San Miguel, passed with a 2/3 majority vote to begin a trial starting April, 2014 for 7 work periods (One Cycle).

Schedule was presented at the annual Chief's Operational Meeting. (Battalion, Division & Deputy Chiefs)

Schedule was presented to the Riverside County Chief's Executive Staff.



Concept

Originated in RRU Battalion 17 to allow a 3 station module equal rotation. It was based off the 48/96 fire department schedule, where the 1st day of your previous working-shift, would be the last day of your upcoming shift.

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Rotating Schedule

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Overview

period(s) ends.

As the days rotate each work period(s), there will be some offset shifts throughout the calendar year.

You'll average 3-4 (24hr & 48hr) shifts a year if you move back each work period.

If you choose to move back after (2) work periods, those (24hr & 48hr) shifts will be reduced.

Each employee will be moving back 2 days when the work

24hr shifts are on <u>Monday's & Sunday's</u> 48hr shifts are on Mon/Tues & Sat/Sun
