WHEREAS, (1) The department is not willing to provide adequate R and R (Rest and Relaxation) to allow for a reasonable amount of rest for all employees while on assignment, covering behind assignments, or being held at fire facilities (Fire Stations, Camps, Air Bases, ECC's, Etc);

WHEREAS, (2) Our employees are being forced out of county on assignments or in unit for coverages behind those out of county assignments upwards to 90 plus days at a time with little to no R and R;

WHEREAS, (3) Each Incident Commander, Supervisor, Etc. of that area where those employees are assigned have their own definition and/or rules how they would like to identify how or when R and R will be given or not given; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, (A) CAL FIRE Local 2881 work with CPF to create legislation at the state level to make any assignment of 2 weeks (14 days consecutive) for all fire personnel, whether on assignment, coving behind those assignments, or fire facility coverage, be given 2 day (48 hours consecutive) R and R per 14 day cycle.
